The nearest ATM is located one block away on the exterior wall around the corner from the grocery store entrance of Miss Cordelia's Grocery & Deli.




On-Site Restaurant



Home of the late Elvis Presley. Guided tours cover the main floor, stable, trophy room, racquetball court, and grave sites. Also tour Elvis' private jet, the Lisa Marie, and the automobile museum.

Memphis Botanic Garden

The Goldsmith Civic Garden Center and Botanic Garden contain eighty-seven thousand acres for camping, hiking, boating, fishing, and horseback riding. Picnic areas available.



Memphis Zoo

Located in Overton Park

Memphis's Largest attraction and home to twenty-eight hundred animals representing four hundred varied species. The zoo included Cat Country, natural free-roaming habitat for exotic and endangered cats, and the Northwest passage, featuring polar bears, sea lions, seals, and bear. This is one of only four U.S. zoos to exhibit giant pandas.

National Civil Rights Museum

Located at the historic site of the Lorraine Motel where Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated, this museum provides a comprehensive overview of the American civil rights movement. Exhibits and interactive displays trace the history of the movement and its leaders.
